A Baptismal Certificate is required before registration can be completed

To be in the Confirmation class a student must have completed two years of Religious Education prior to the class either in a Catholic School, Youth Group or Home Schooled. Since there are only 8 regular classes -any absence is considered reason for concern. You must contact the Director of Religious Education immediately if you have any absences.

The STUDENTS share the obligation of all Roman Catholics to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. The Religious Education program strives to promote participation in Mass by the whole family. Parents must accept the responsibility as a sacred duty. Parents must further understand that students who are not regular participants at Sunday Mass and the Parish School of Religion/ Youth Group may not be admitted to Sacramental preparation classes.
